

GA Barnie Group doesn't manufacture any products but installs and maintains electrical, mechanical, renewable, fire and CCTV systems. The choice of products used is client-driven but when we can, we purchase products and materials sourced locally. The company is ISO14001 certified (as are our key suppliers) and our aspect & impact assessment identified vehicle transport emissions and energy use in offices as our most significant aspects.

The company is aware of the effect that building works can have on both the local community and the environment and we endeavour to keep vehicle movements to a minimum by the use of crew buses for engineers. This in turn causes less traffic congestion as well as reducing pollution to the local environment. The company has also been investing in reducing fleet emissions by purchasing hybrid company cars and electric vans to help lessen CO2 emissions. We have renewable energy installations fitted at several branches and an LED lighting replacement program is ongoing.

The company has a waste carriers licence, which allows us to bring waste from sites for segregation at one of our branches. We segregate metals, waste electrical & electronic equipment, batteries, redundant lamps, waste oils, cardboard, office recyclables and wood for recycling. We track fuel, energy, and waste metrics regularly and convert these to carbon equivalent figures.

We are participants in both the Energy Savings Opportunities Scheme (ESOS) and recently the Streamlined Emissions Carbon Reporting scheme (SECR). Our company objectives have included improving building insulation, installing more renewable technologies, and growing our hybrid vehicle fleet further.
